

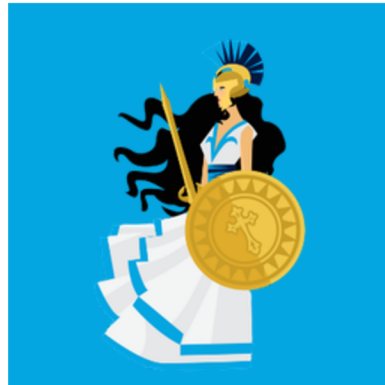

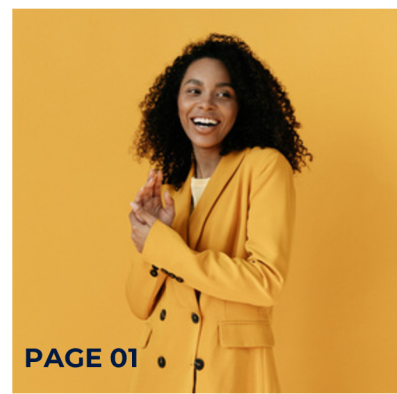

2025: A Year of Measurable Growth & Deepening Healing

In 2025, Warrior Bride Ministries experienced meaningful growth in survivor care, expanded programming, and increased engagement from individuals seeking safe, faith-centered healing environments. Survivors continued to pursue restoration through individual sessions, discipleship, and supportive community spaces designed for long-term transformation.

SUPPORTING SURVIVORS, TRANSFORMING LIVES.

In 2025, Warrior Bride Ministries experienced increased survivor engagement, strong participation in healing groups, and successful events, including the annual conference and the first ministry training retreat. These milestones highlight the growing need for integrated spiritual care, trauma-informed support, and leadership development. In response, the ministry plans to expand training, discipleship, and survivor support services in 2026, while also increasing capacity for housing assistance and crisis response partnerships.

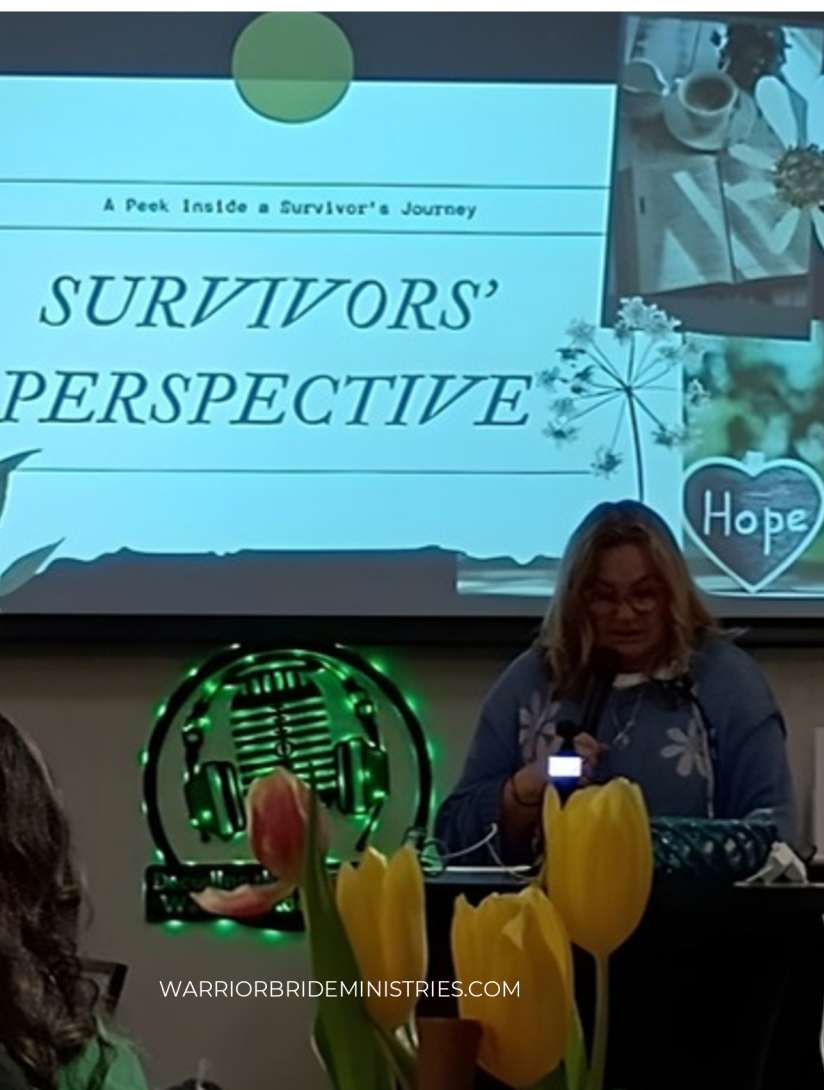
